We will be taking a trailer of donated items to Grace Covenant Ministries in Annville for their thrift stores. Trailer will be available in the church parking lot from March 18 to March 31. Only items in good to excellent condition please. Specific items that are needed: Household items, clothing, tools, toys, etc. Women's clothing and small household appliances are high demand items. They do take winter clothing as it does get fairly cold in the mountains in the winter. If possible bring your items in a box for more compact packing. If you need boxes picked up from your house please call the church office.

Community Cupboard

You can continue to bless *Harvest Stand Ministries* through the Community Cupboard. Most needed items are: toilet paper, shampoo, toothpaste, feminine hygiene products, laundry detergent, dish soap, pinto beans, chili (no beans), walnuts, mayonnaise, pasta sauce, tomato sauce, sugar, stewed tomatoes, canned yams, sliced potatoes, corn, pineapple chunks, mandarin oranges, and bread.
